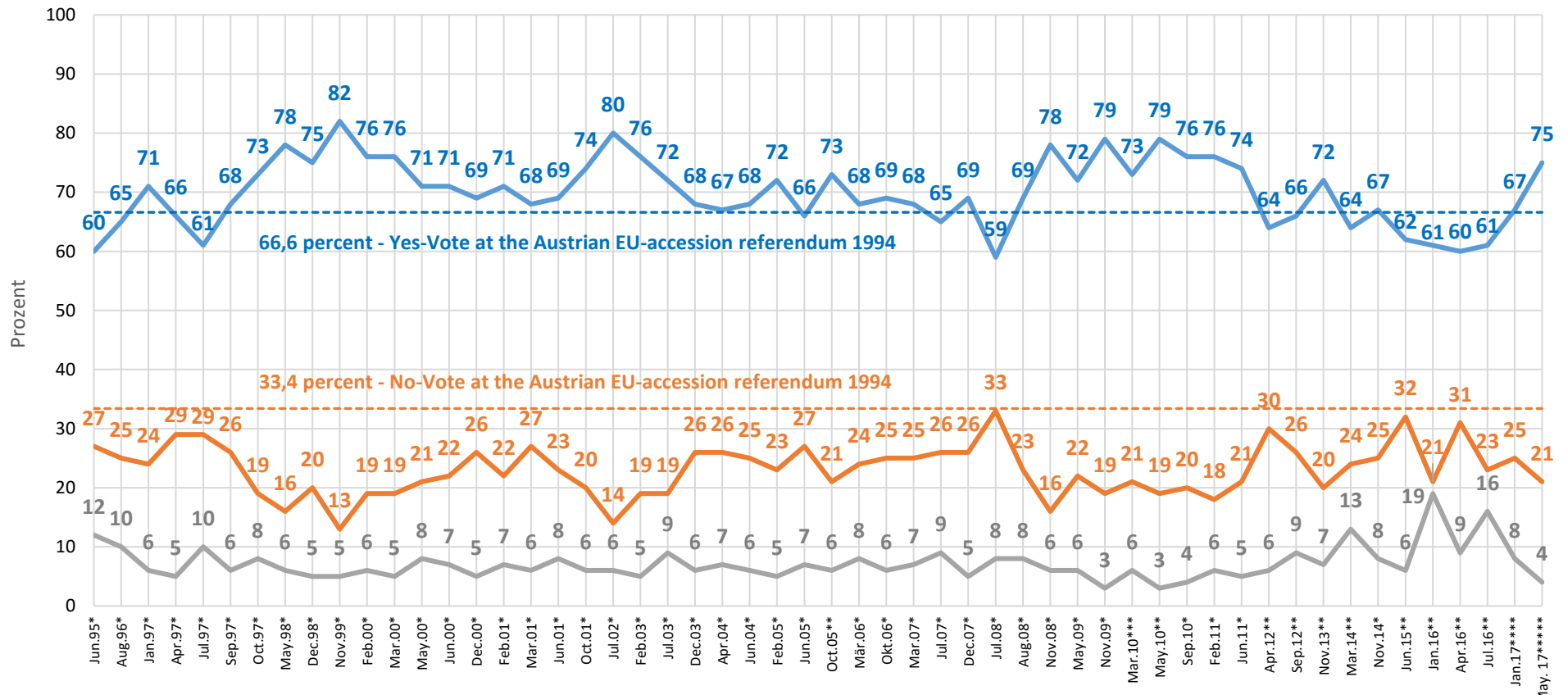


Should Austria remain a member of the European Union or leave it?

- - - No-Vote at the Austrian EU-accession referendum 1994 (33,4 percent)



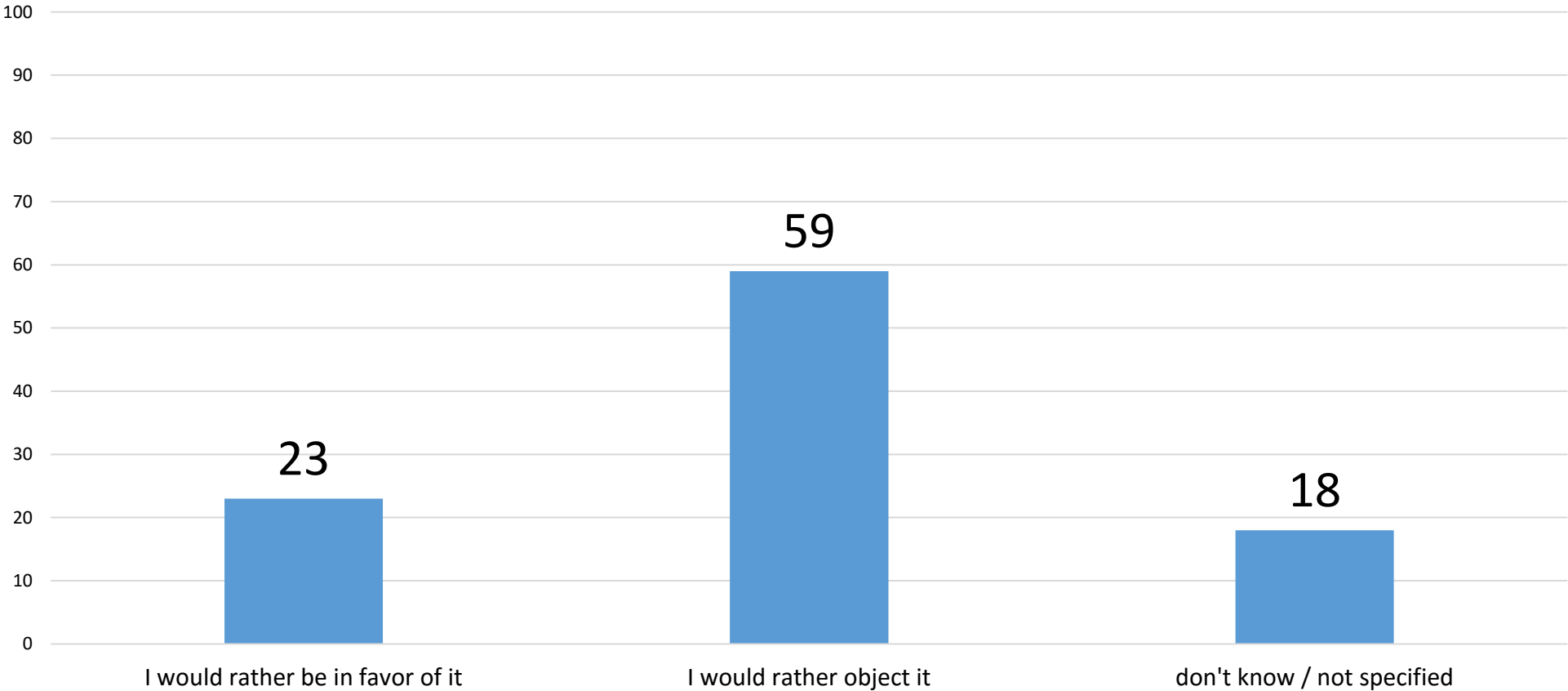

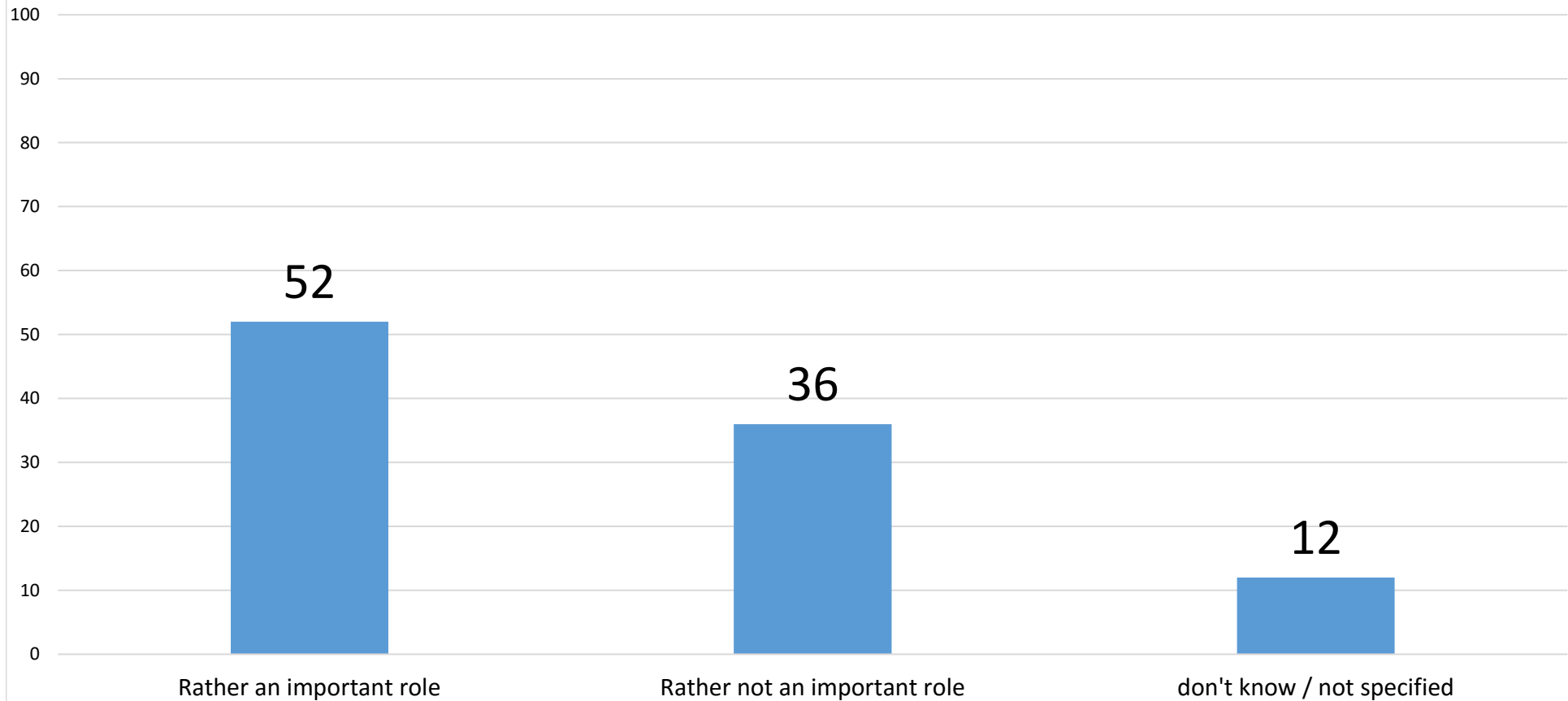
Average "remain": 69,9 percent

Do you think that the reform of the European Union should play a prominent role in the course of the upcoming parliamentary elections?

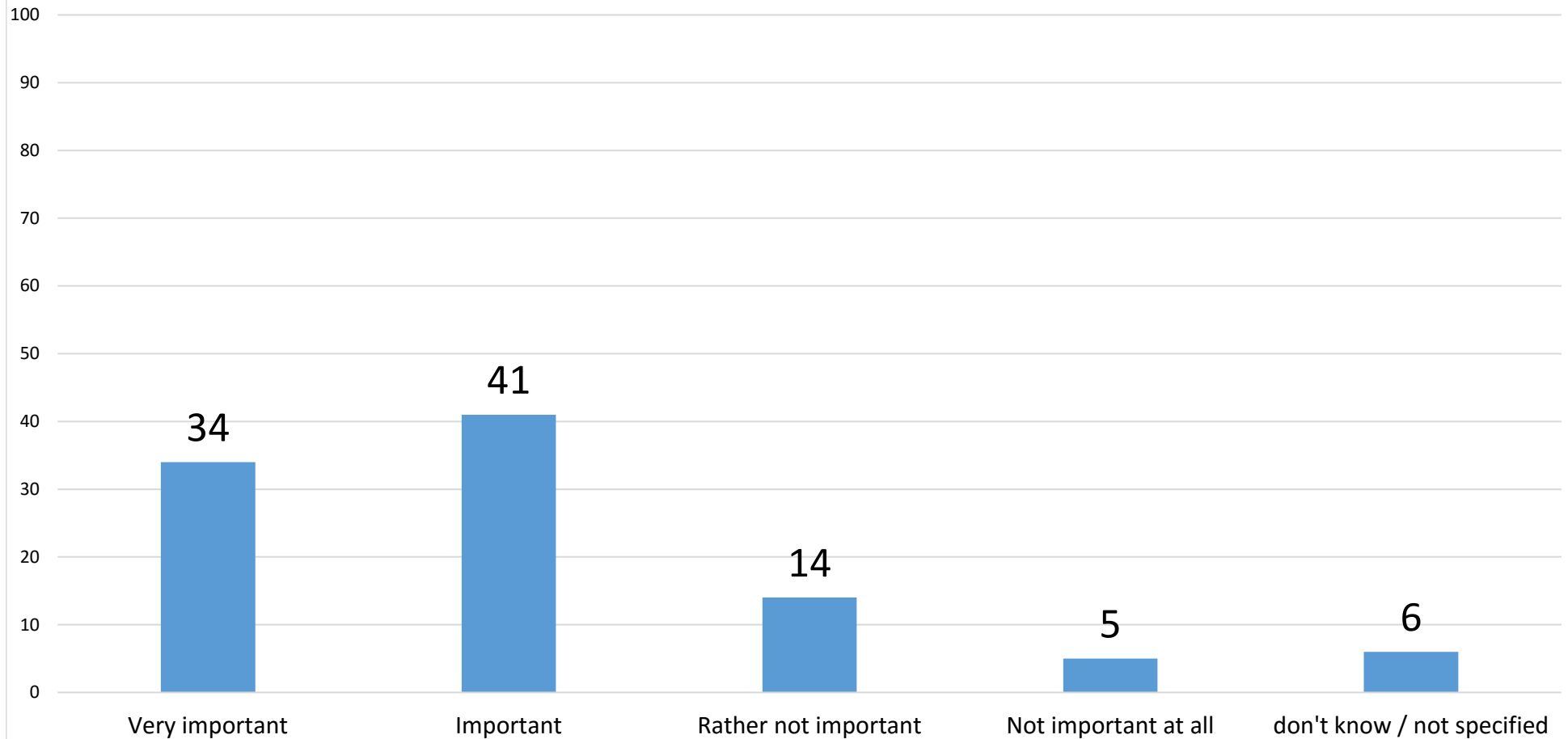
